3	(a) In General.—Subsection (a) of section 203 of
4	the Department of Energy Organization Act (42 U.S.C.

7	"(12) Energy emergency and energy security
8	functions, including—
9	"(A) responsibilities with respect to infra-
10	structure, cybersecurity, emerging threats, sup-
11	ply, and emergency planning, coordination, re-
12	sponse, and restoration; and
13	"(B) upon request of a State, local, or
14	tribal government or energy sector entity, and
15	in consultation with other Federal agencies as
16	appropriate, provision of technical assistance,
17	support, and response capabilities with respect

20	(b) COORDINATION.—The Secretary of Energy shall
