To amend title III of the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize the National Center on Birth Defects and Developmental Disabilities, and for other purposes. 3

4	This Act may be cited as the "Improving the Health
5	of Children Act".
6	SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE NATIONAL CENTER ON

8	ABILITIES.
9	Section 317C of the Public Health Service Act (42
